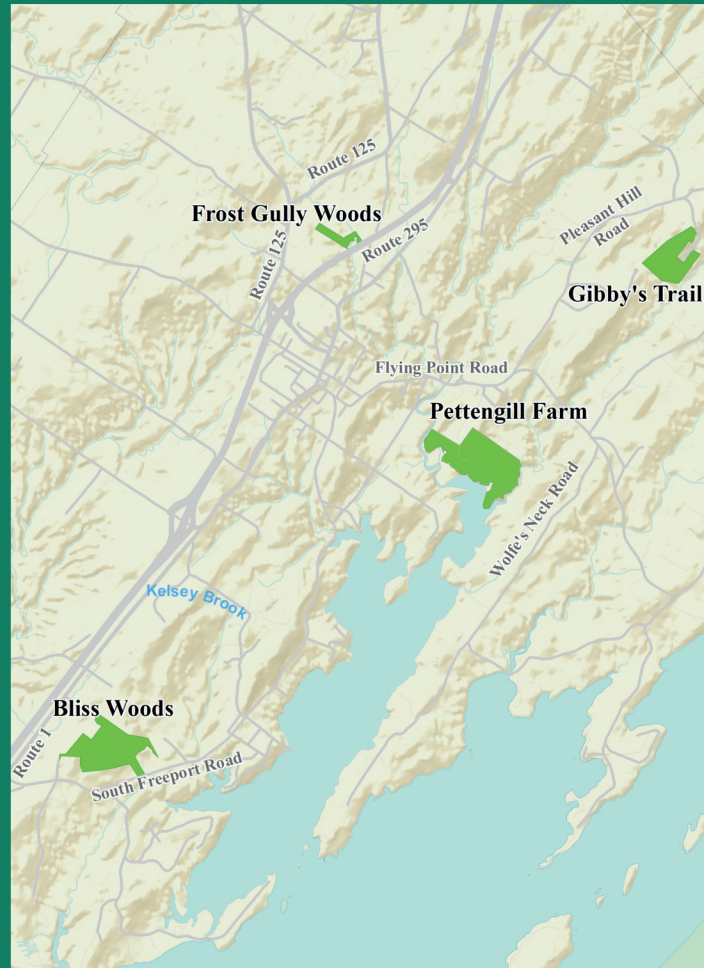

Trail Directions

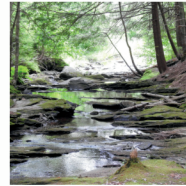
Bliss Woods: Stonewood Dr.

From Route 1 turn onto Stonewood Drive, across from Old County Rd. The trailhead and parking are located at the end of Stonewood Drive.



Frost Gully Woods: 56 Durham Rd./Burr Cemetery.

Frost Gully Woods trailhead is accessed from Burr Cemetery, off Durham Rd. Drive down the driveway to the back of the cemetery and turn left. There is a small parking area at the north-eastern boundary of Burr Cemetery.



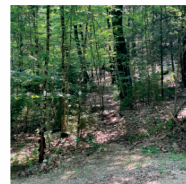
Pettengill Farm: 31 Pettengill Rd.

From Main Street in Freeport head down Bow Street for 1.4 miles. Turn right on Pettengill Road. Park by the welcome sign and walk into the farm.



Gibby's Trail: Ringrose Rd.

From Pleasant Hill Rd. turn onto Ringrose Rd. Parking and trailhead are approximately 1/8 mile on the left of Ringrose Rd.
